### 3. Master Plan

- Prototypes of the models have been drafted, with 3D modelling to follow. Models will be a part of the SALA exhibition.
- At each stage of progression, models will go out for public consultation. Once finalised, funding will then be sorted.
- Peter is assisting with software development.
- All community notice boards will be populated with the master plan updates.

### 4. Kanmantoo Copper Mine Update

#### Mental Health Awareness Month

- HGO gave an update on mental health awareness month, which covered The Blue Tree Project and Mental Health First Aider accredited training. Karlene thanked HGO and commended the work.
- **Action for Viv to send the Blue Tree Project video to the council.**
- Commentary was made on the emergency mental health services available in Mount Barker.
- The public commented that they have never heard of the Blue Tree Project. **Action for Viv to put the article forward to the Courier.**

#### Environmental - Dust

- One dust exceedance on the 4<sup>th</sup> May, which was missed due to it being masked by a large regional dust event the subsequent day.
- HGO will report all exceedances to Mark Stewart via the new template immediately.
- Rainfall data is the third lowest since 2012.
- Computer hardware and software have been upgraded to ensure compliance. Currently in the process of establishing an SMS alert system for real-time notifications.
- HGO to provide dust data to the public if requested.
- A discussion was held around the composition of dust. John Crocker to investigate historic processes for dust composition analysis.
- HGO to present dust monitoring data as a graph for the next meeting.

#### Environmental – TSF

- No updates.

#### Environmental – Noise

- Monitoring conducted on 23<sup>rd</sup> July. One exceedance at the back of Callington Rd of 44dB(A), which exceeded the nighttime PEPR target of 40dB(A) but was below the policy target of 51dB(A).

#### Environmental – Vibration

- Reaffirmed blasting times of 6:30-7:30 am/pm and Nugent independent firing for development headings only.

#### Groundwater modelling

- One borehole (KMB30) monitor is in exceedance; however, the surrounding satellite sites are in compliance
- Groundwater compliance to be reported at next meeting.

### Environmental – Rehab & Revegetation

- Update on Grassy Woodlands Project and Second Nature Conservatory.
- Seed viability testing is currently underway to inform scale of works to be conducted. Seed will either have to be farmed or sourced.
- Update on direct seeding and tube stocks methodologies.
- Discussion on xanthuria species on site and in surrounding areas.
- All compliant with the latest EBPC audit. Only suggestion made was for an upgrade of fencing and for soil viability testing.

### Mine Operations

## **5. Other Business**

### Kanmantoo Grassy Woodland Project

- Further planting is still required, with new tree guards being installed
- Planting is being undertaken at the O’Shea property
- Praise given on the planting efforts and the visuals of surrounding plants, and an increase in bird (firetails) activity.
- Ed gave an update on the native veg corridor with planting on Eclair mine road to occur on 10<sup>th</sup> August.

### Callington Lighting

- Planned to be finished by September.
- SACA grant was successful. An event to officially turn on the lights is being hosted, with HGO encouraged to be a part of it.

- Steve Seal encouraged all to stop for a coffee on Friday, 8<sup>th</sup> August, from 2pm-4pm at Britannia for an update on the Quarry.
- Garry Duncan invited all to attend the Britannia to see the models for the heritage project.
