3. Master Plan

- Sub-committee has been finalised with HGO appointing a representative (Steph Cross – HR Superintendent).
- The meeting has not yet occurred due to scheduling conflicts. Meeting proposed for week commencing 28 April 2025.

4. Kanmantoo Copper Mine Update

Environmental - Dust

- Twice daily blasting occurring with no exceedances recorded.
- HGO undertaking all required monitoring noting that the bulk of dust issues are regional and not generated by the mine.
- Low rainfall is contributing to the amount of regional dust, however with HGO underground operations, dust generated is significantly lower than open pit mining.

Environmental – TSF

- Regularity of sequential movement creates a funnel that the water flows through. Dry surfaces become a source of dust however it is in good condition despite current dry conditions.
- Progressive rehab will reduce risk for dust.

Environmental – Noise

- Remains under compliance limits.

Environmental – Vibration

- Monitoring will occur for life of mine, noting that less vibrations occur in underground mining.

Environmental – Rehab & Revegetation

- HGO needs to assess what is currently in stock, how resourceful it will be and how we can get to a program that meets ongoing requirements, though it is hard to know how it would perform right now.
- Aim will be to keep program realistic, not aspirational based on commercial capacity.
- It was asked that John Crocker consider how he can pass on his learnings to local community members for their respective land.

Mine Operations

5. Other Business

Callington Lighting (Rose Ashton)

- Currently at second stage with tranching commencing 14 April.

- Awaiting outcome of grant from SACA to upgrade from 150 LUX to 300 LUX allowing night cricket games to occur.

Heidelberg (Steve Seal)

- Concrete mobile plant is currently at application stage noting that even if approved, things may not progress.
- Offer made to KCCCC members to undertake site tour.
- Contract crusher engaged and due to commence crushing in May.
- Requirements for dust and noise will be as per current PEPR.
